

When selecting music for funerals, consider the following:

- 1. All music during the liturgy should be sacred music as opposed to secular music. When in doubt about musical selections, please contact Patrick Stolz, music director at St. Mary's Cathedral.**
- 2. The funeral liturgy Mass is a sung rite. Therefore, the responsorial psalm should be led by the cantor at the ambo and should be sung. Likewise the following Mass Parts should be sung: Gospel Acclamation, Sanctus, Memorial Acclamation, Amen, Lamb of God and the Song of Farewell.**
- 3. An Entrance hymn, Communion hymn and Sending Forth hymn should be chosen from the attached list of suggestions to be sung by the congregation and led by the cantor.**
- 4. Solo, congregational hymn or special music should be chosen at presentation and preparation of the gifts.**
- 5. The organist should prepare prelude and postlude music.**
- 6. All music should be done by live musicians and needs to be sacred in nature.**

Below is a list of appropriate hymns. Other appropriate selections can be made with the consent of the Music Director or pastor. Most music can be found in the worship aides, namely "Today's Missal" and "Music Issue" from OCP Publications.
